- Roman bridge










- Good climate: hot and dry summer softened by altitude

- 214 km from Madrid
- From Estación Sur (Méndez Alvaro), every hour, from 7am to 10pm
- Direct trip (no stops) takes about 2:30 hours
- About 23 euros one-way

- Some people may find it more convenient



- Founded in 1519 for Galician students
- Now for professors, researchers and visitors
- Well located, in downtown






- 41 rooms (single and double)

# Restaurant and rooms




# Hotel Abba Fonseca
