

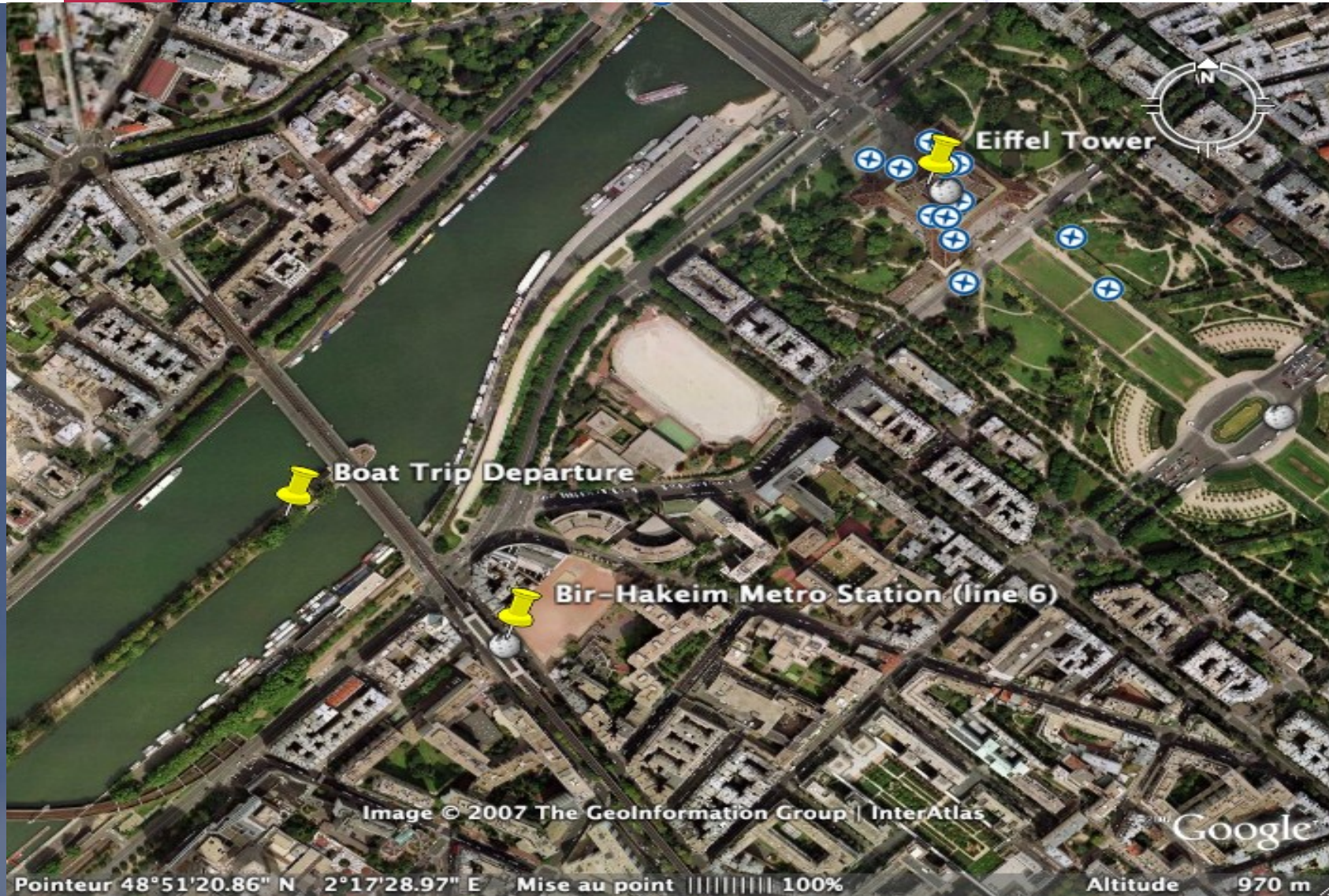
WELCOME TO PARIS
